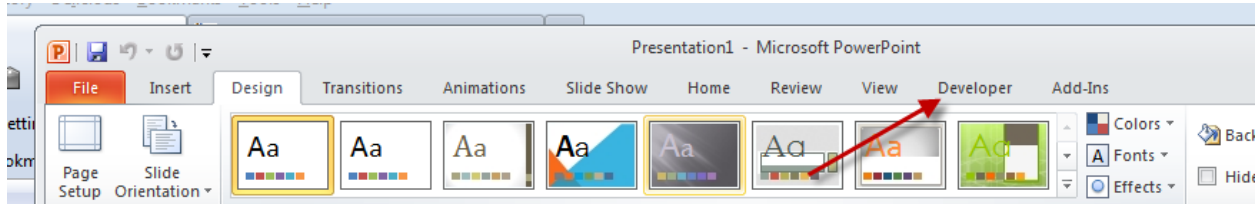


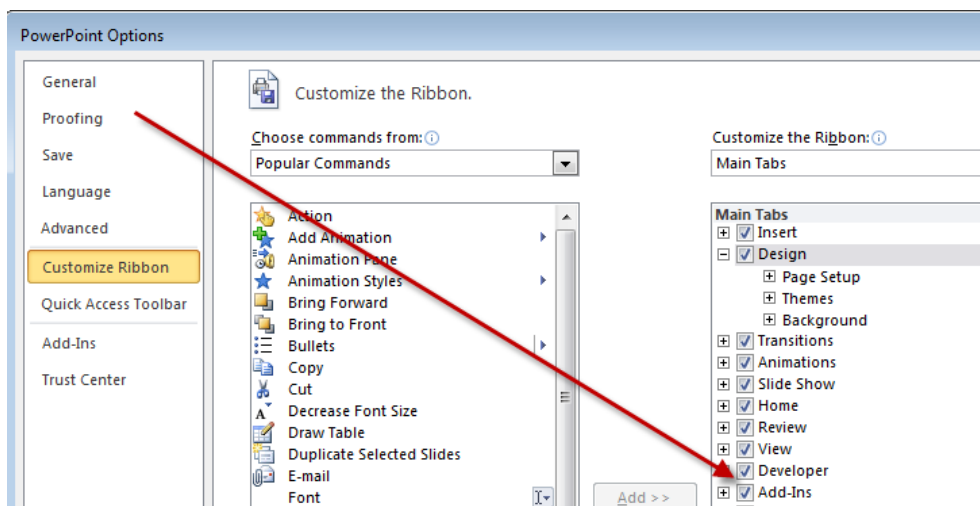
How to put a YouTube video into your PowerPoint presentation

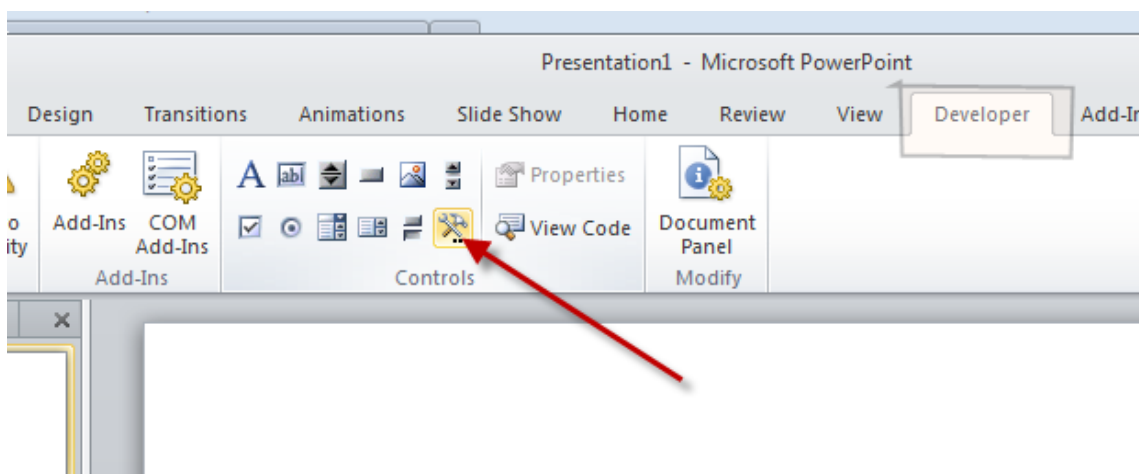
Make sure the Developer tab is showing in the ribbon.



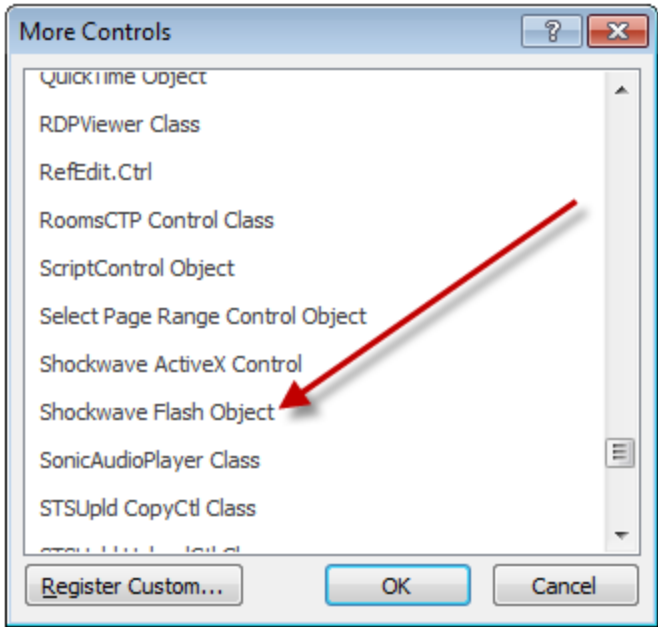
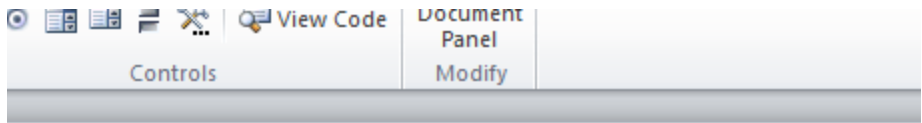
If it is not, go to File>PowerPoint Options>Customize ribbon and check Developer:



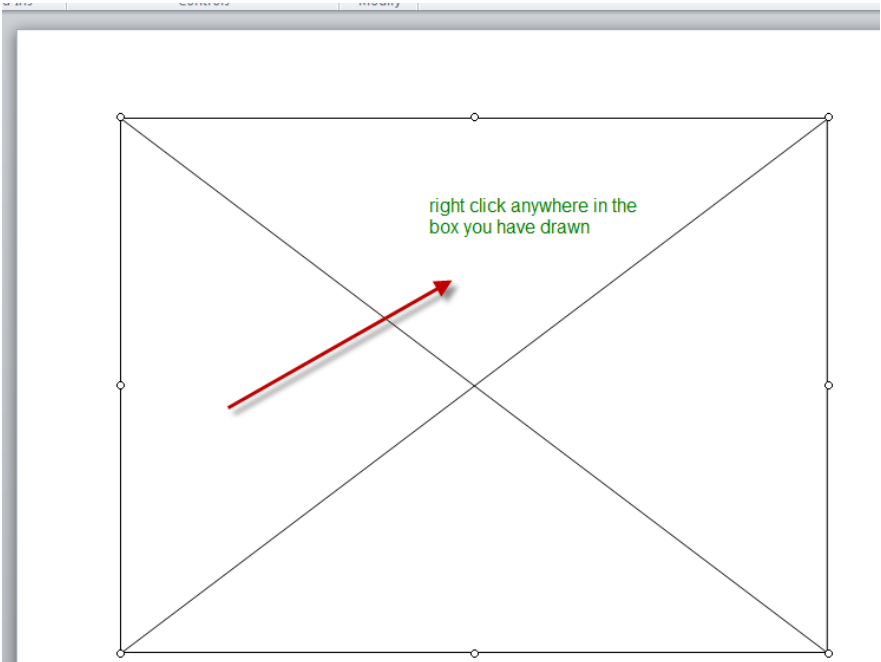
On the Developer tab, click More Controls:



Scroll down until you see Shockwave Flash Object and choose that



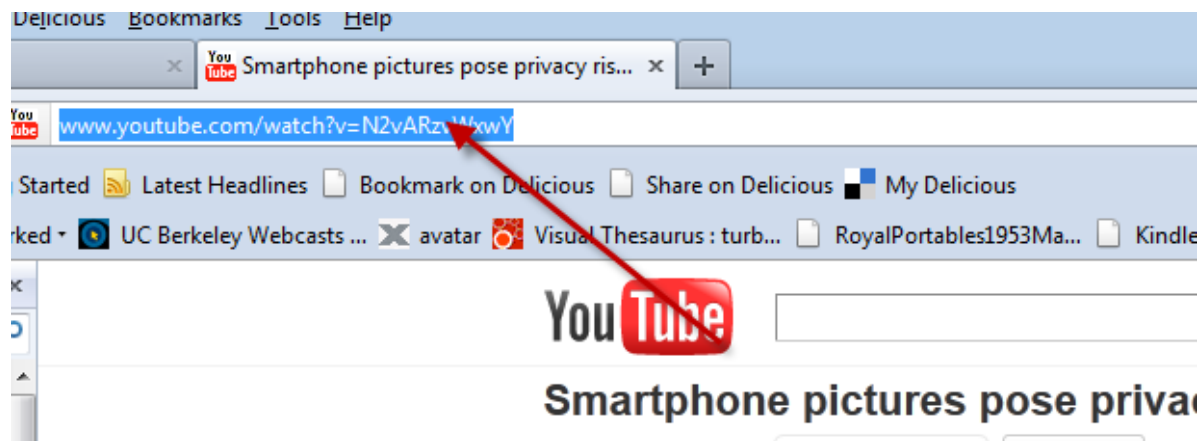
Using your mouse, draw a rectangle the size of the video screen you want, then right click:



Go to Properties and select Movie:
