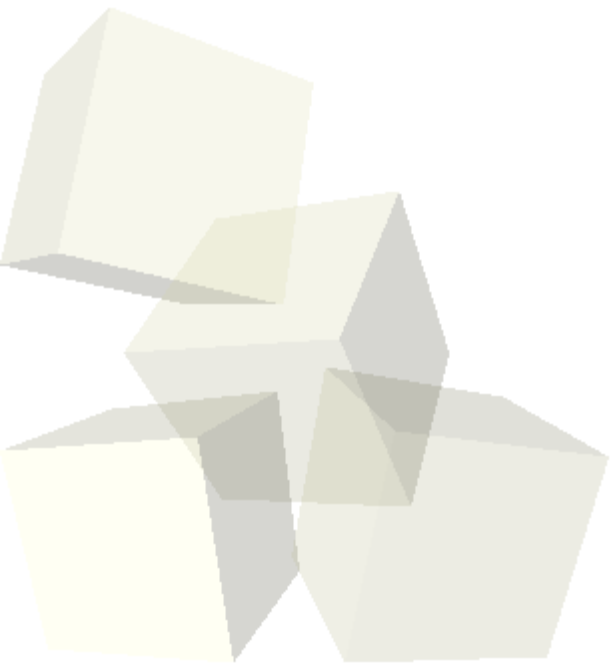
Data Presentation

- The format and write commands give you the ability to do report style printing.



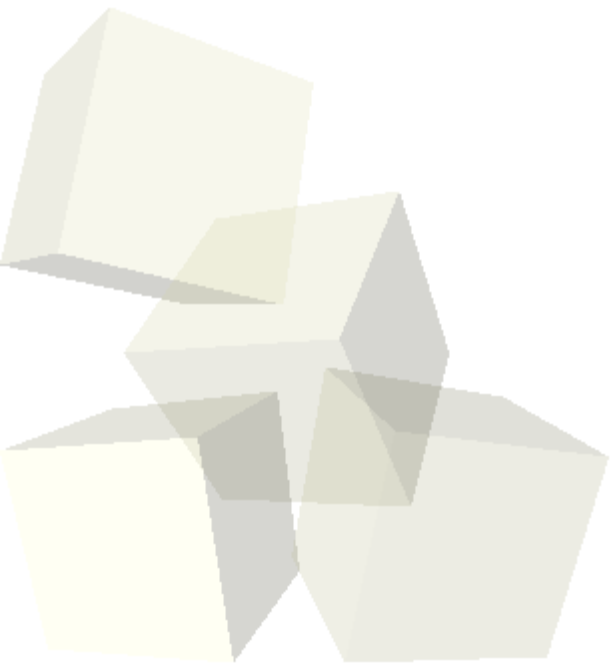
