


Figure 1: Example of using the automata library to draw something for CSCI 2321, namely something equivalent to Figure B.10.2.




Figure 2: The example from Figure 1, drawn in a different style.

Figures 1 and 2 show examples of using LaTeX's $TikZ^1$ library to draw finite-state diagrams as in Appendix B of the textbook.
