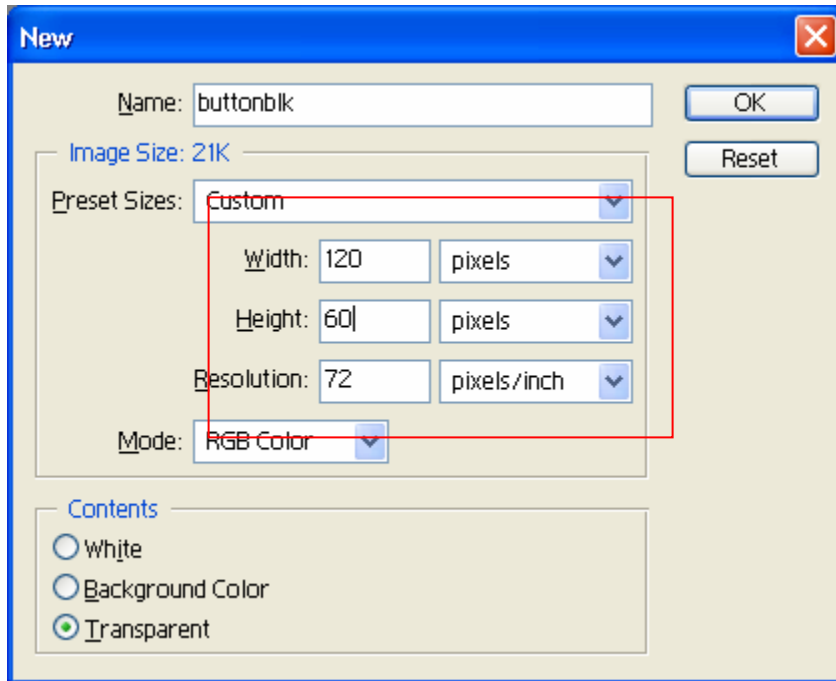
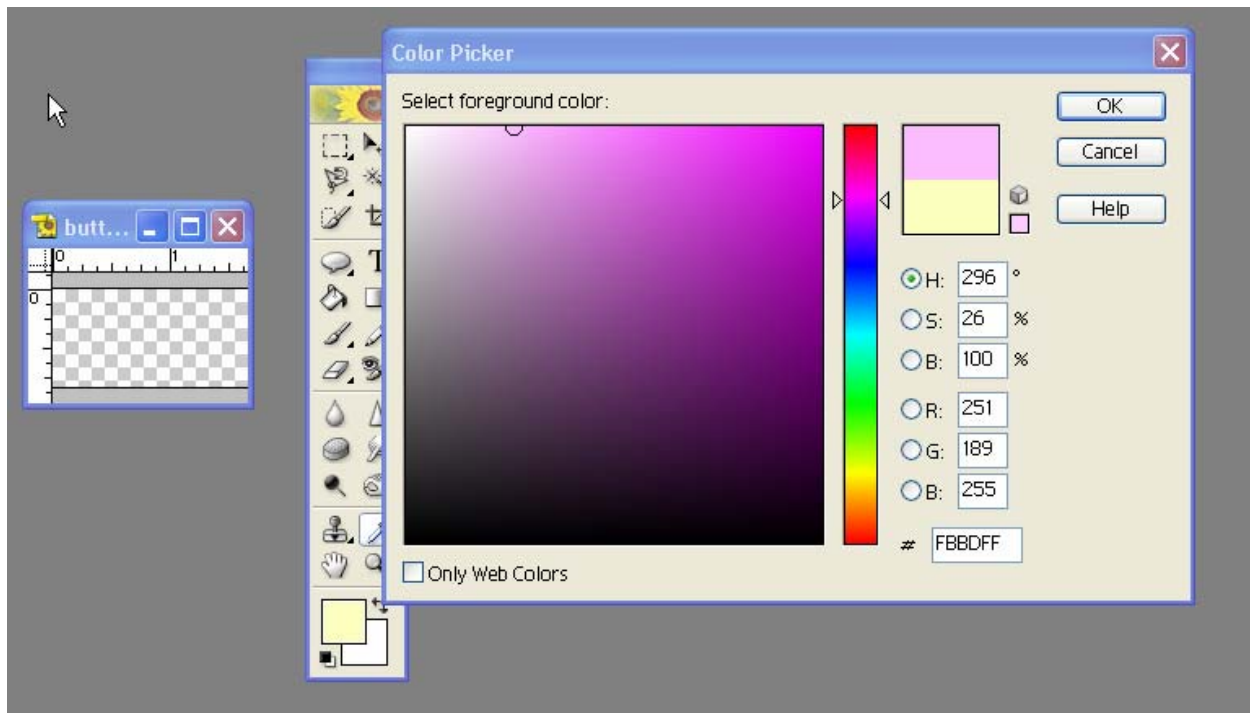


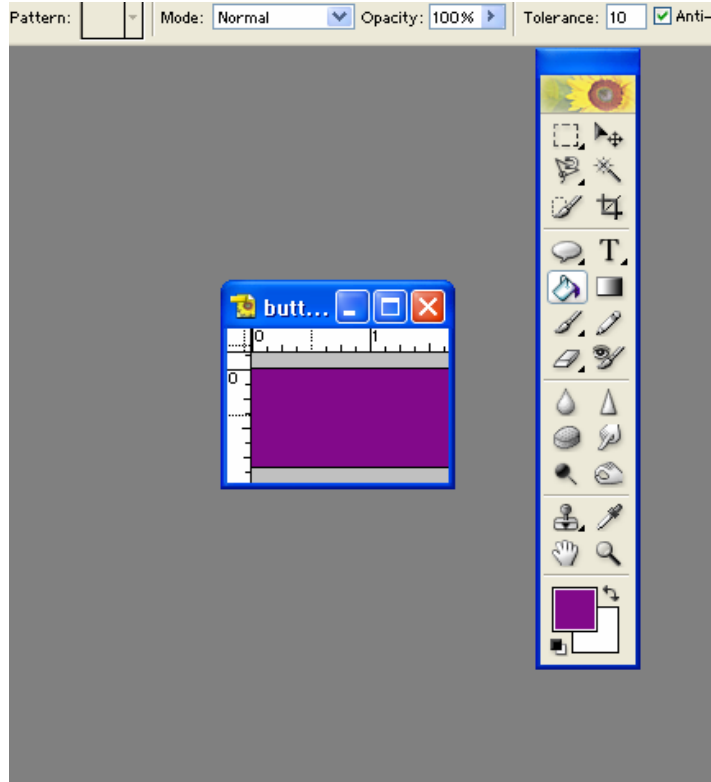
Open up Photoshop Elements and determine what size you want your button to be.



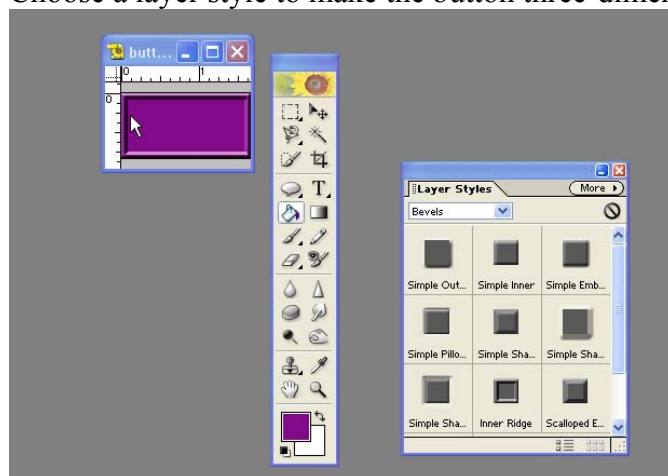
When the file comes up, choose a fill color by clicking on the foreground square.



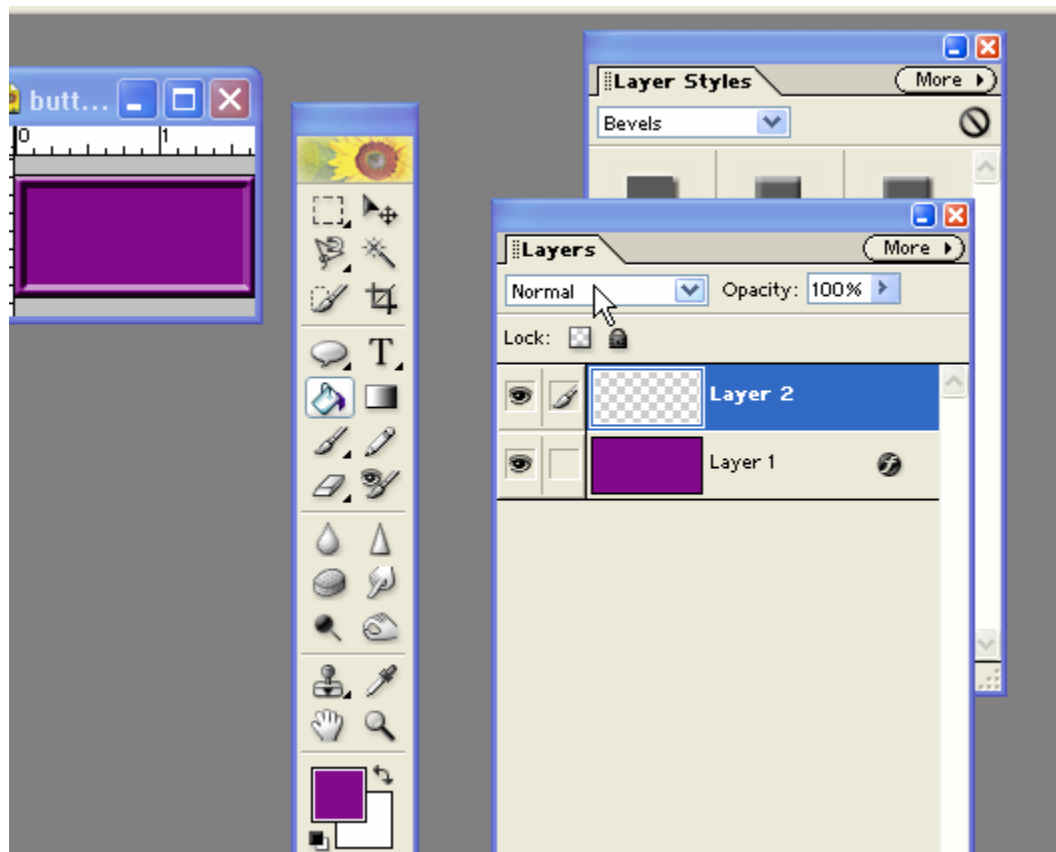
Fill the area with the desired color.



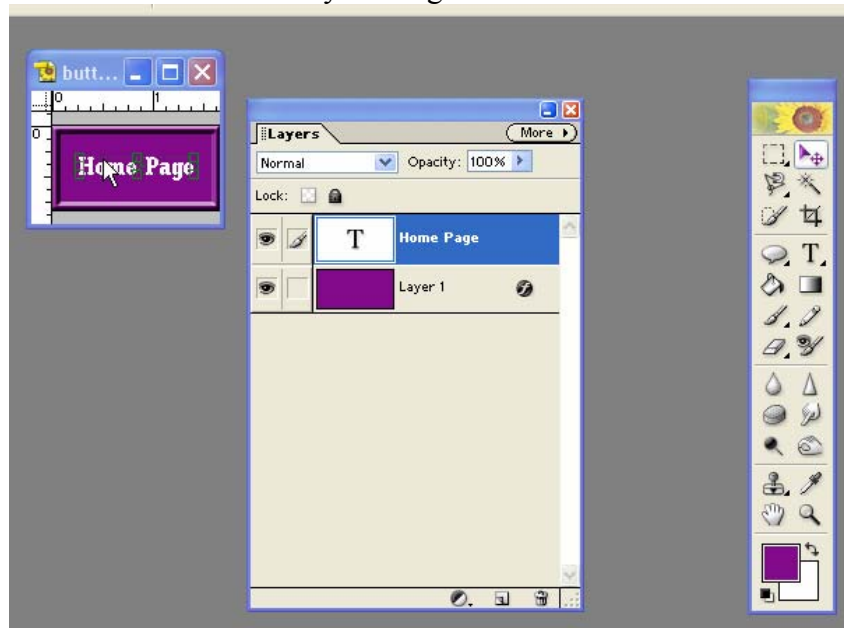
Choose a layer style to make the button three-dimensional. Save. This will be your blank button.



Add a new layer – this will be the start of your first button with text on it.



Add descriptive text and **Save for Web** – important to save as a different file than the blank button each time to make a new version with different text. Make it descriptive – Homebutton, etc. Be sure to save it in your images folder!



Continue to build as many buttons as you need, using new words and “Saving for Web” each time using a different descriptive name for each version. Save each one in your images folder.



Insert your images wherever you want using Front Page, and hyperlink them to the desired pages or websites.
