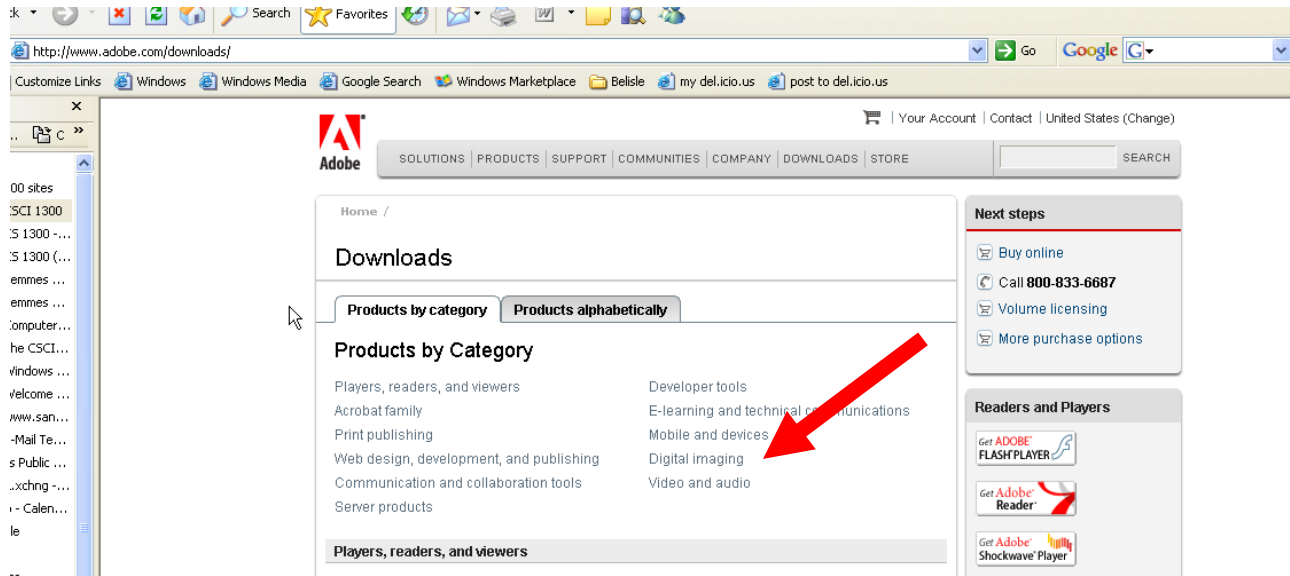

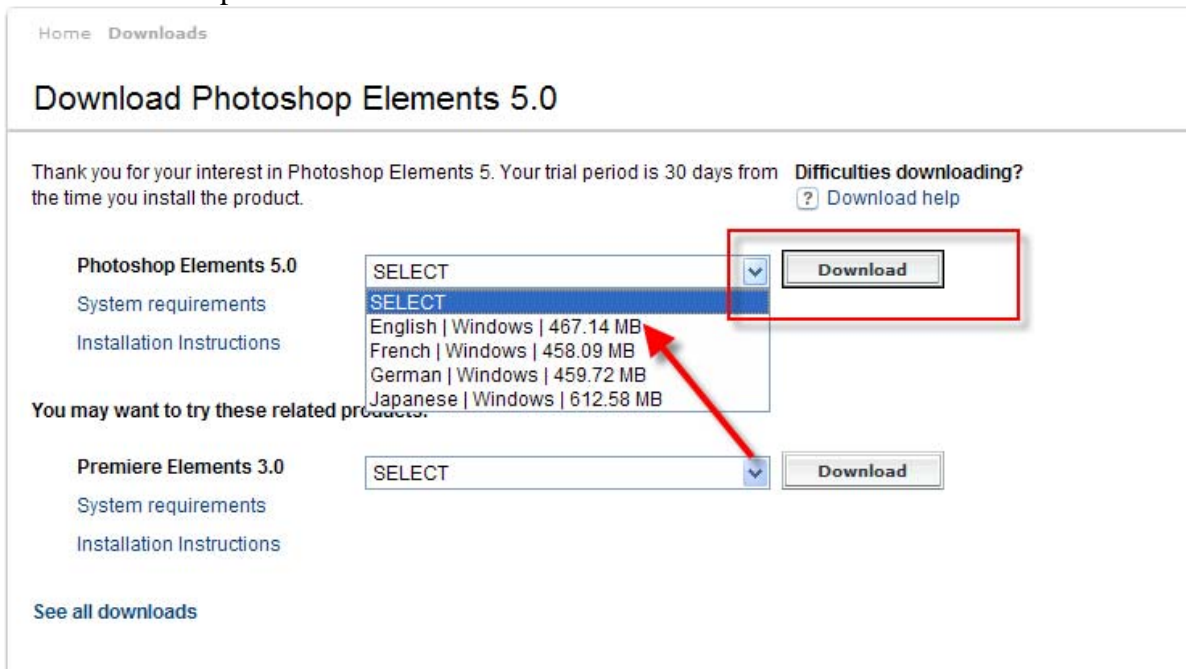

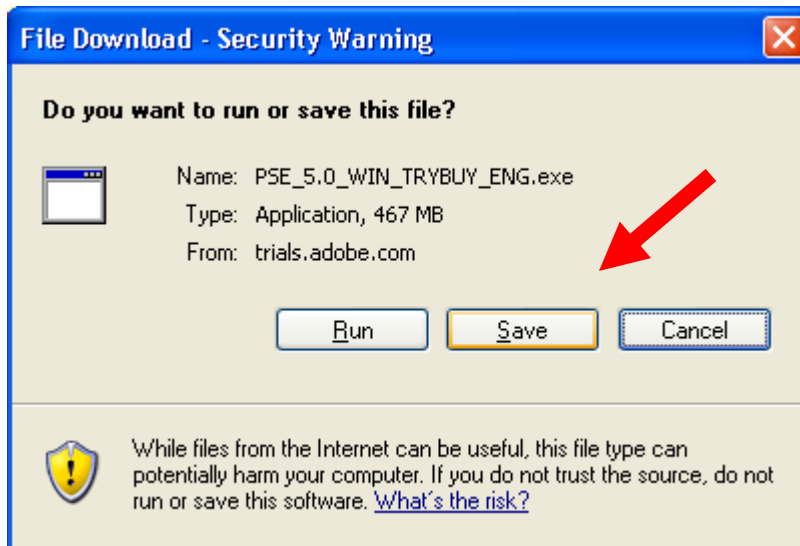
Select the Digital Imaging category:



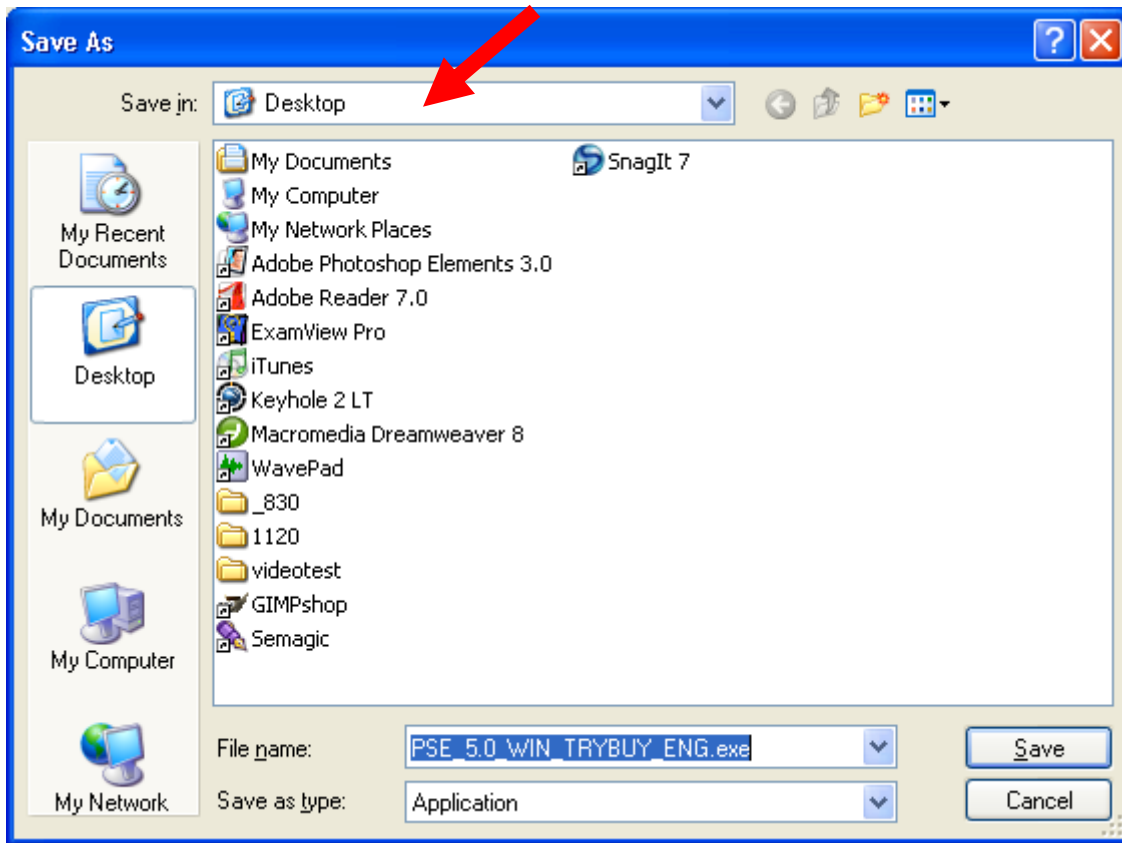
Find Adobe Photoshop Elements 5.0 and select:



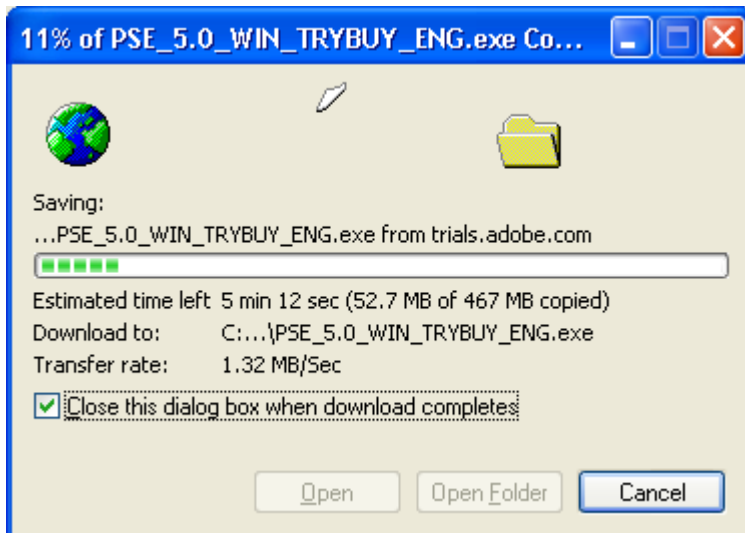
You will be asked to create an Adobe account if you don't already have one. Once this is set up, the download window will open. Choose Save:



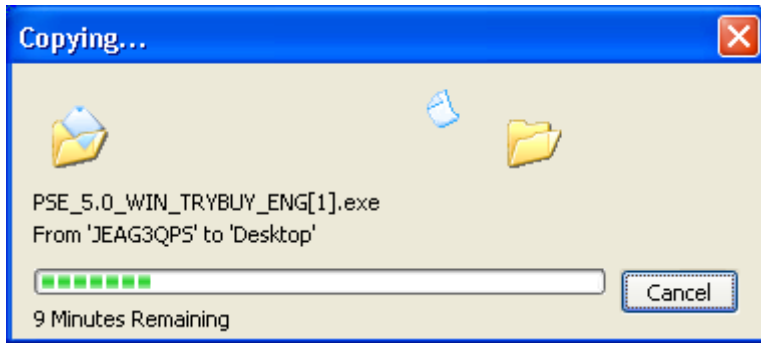
Choose Desktop as the place to save:

A second screen places the .exe file on the desktop (this also takes about ten minutes)



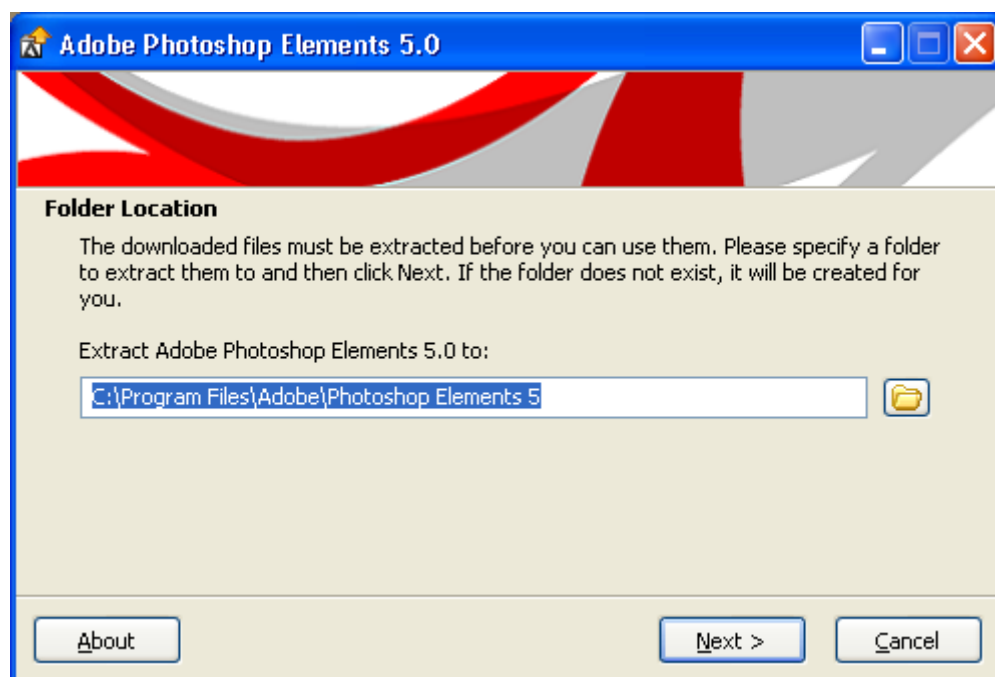
Click on the file on your Desktop:



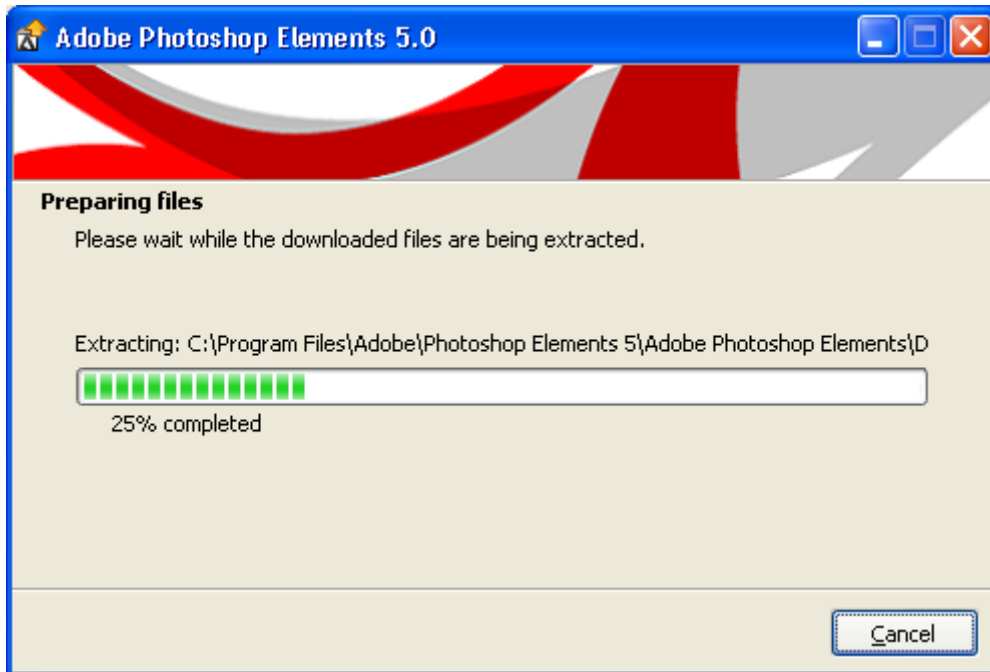
Click Run:



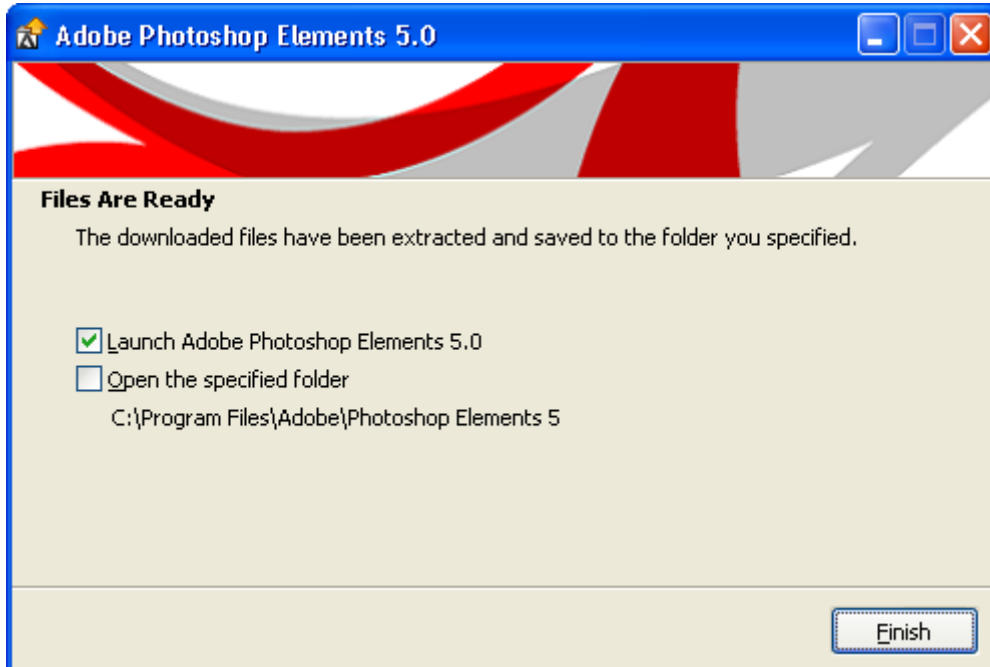
Click Next (verify the C:\Programs Files location)



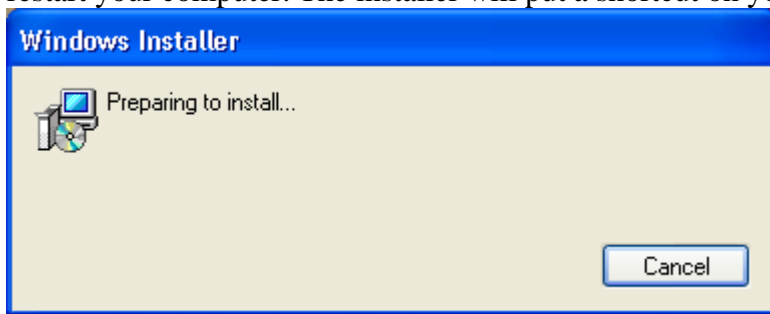
Files will be extracted:
