


Importing Images into Your Expression Web Site Images Folder

Always import images through Expression Web – do not copy and paste, which may make your images unstable and unusable.

Collect your images in a separate “working” folder while you edit them for your website in Photoshop Elements or another photo editing program.

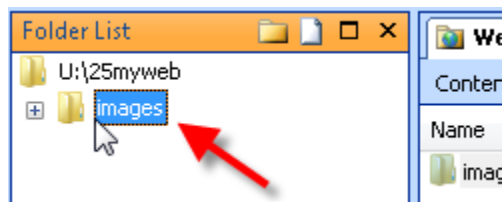
- Brightness/Contrast
- Resizing
- Color Correction, including Red Eye
- Filters
- Save for Web

When your photos and graphics are ready to be placed in your web pages, locate your website folder – in this case, it is the KeyWestphotos folder inside of 24webplan:

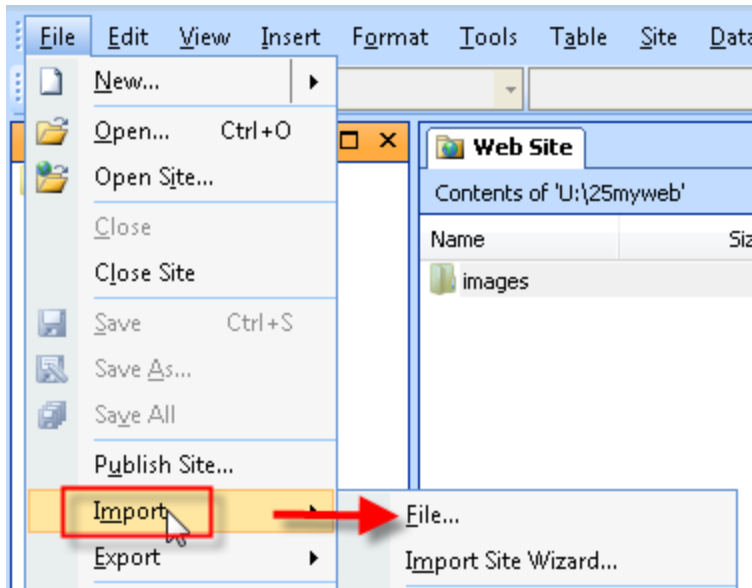

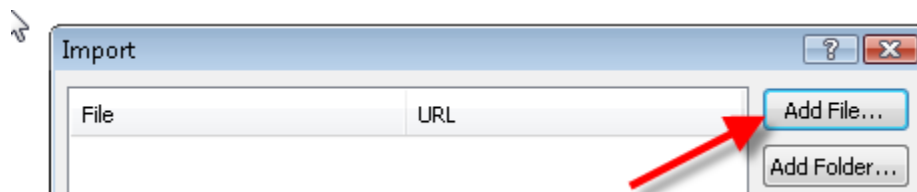
In Expression Web, make sure the images folder is selected:



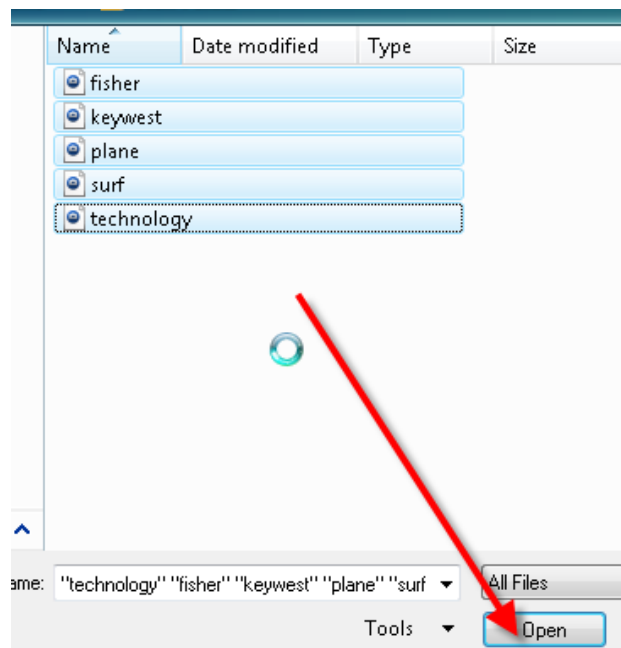
Go to File>Import>File:



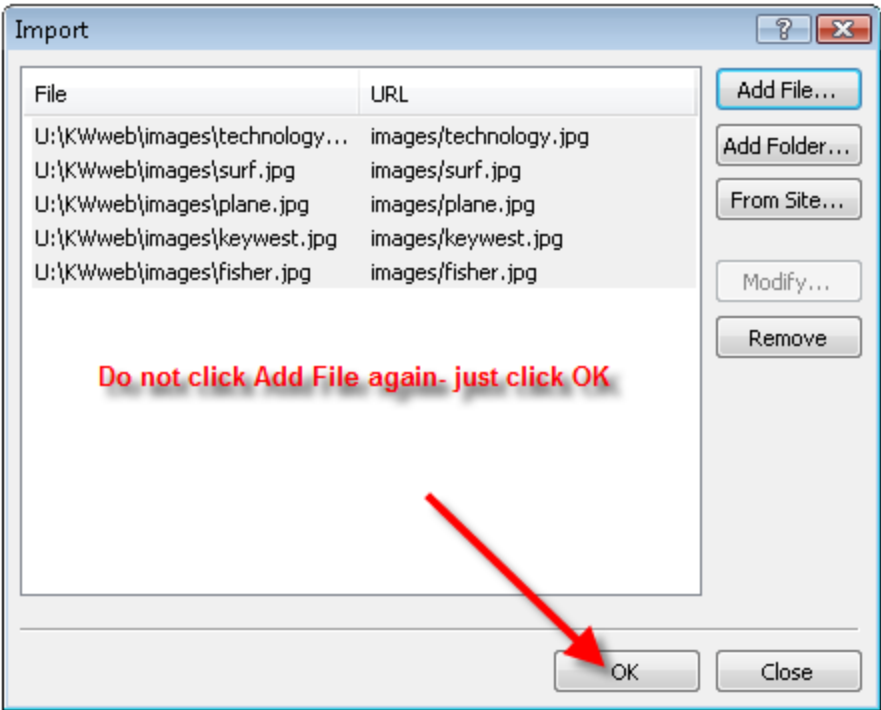
Click Add File:



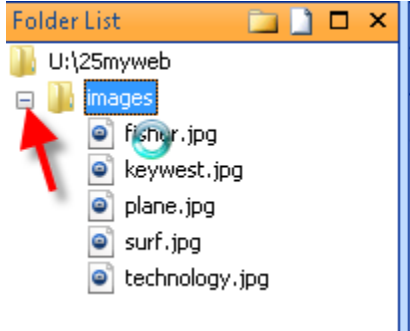
Then Navigate to the KeyWestphotos and open it select all of files and click Open:



You will see the files added to the import window – click OK.



When you click the plus sign next to the images folder, you will see that the files have been imported successfully:
