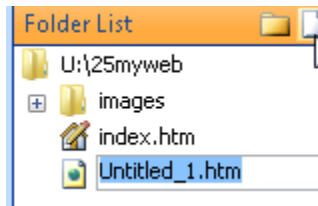


Making a New Page and Hyperlinks in Expression Web

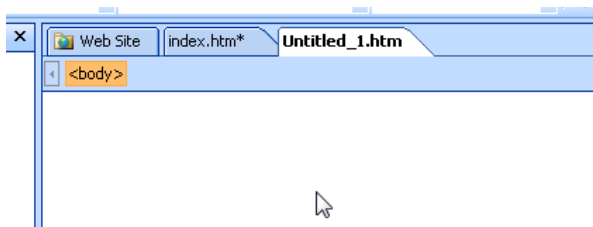
With your home page (index) open and its tab showing at the top, click on the New Page icon:



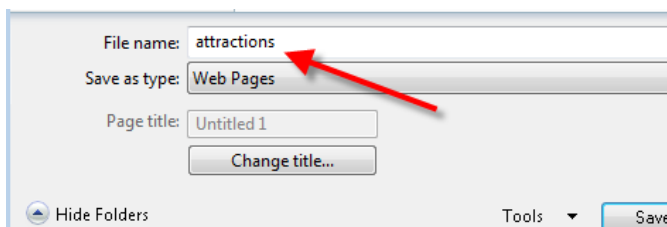
A new, untitled page appears in the folder list:



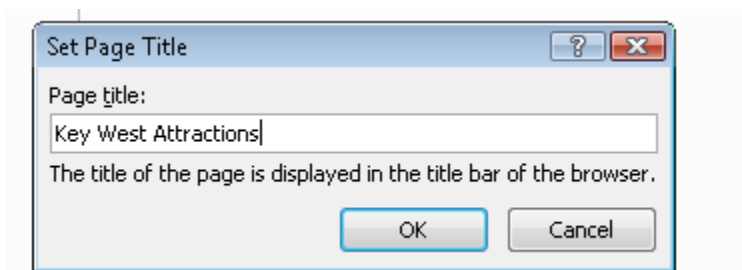
Double click to open it and you will see its tab at the top – you can switch back and forth between pages using the tabs:



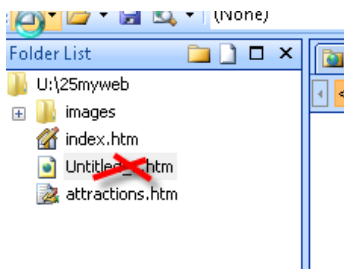
All pages should have descriptive file names and titles, so we will save this page under a different name in this case, “attractions”:



But before we save it, we will also change the title to Key West Attractions:



At this point, we can delete the untitled page:



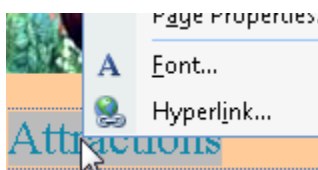
Add some text, format it, and change the page color – remember to coordinate your design on both pages:



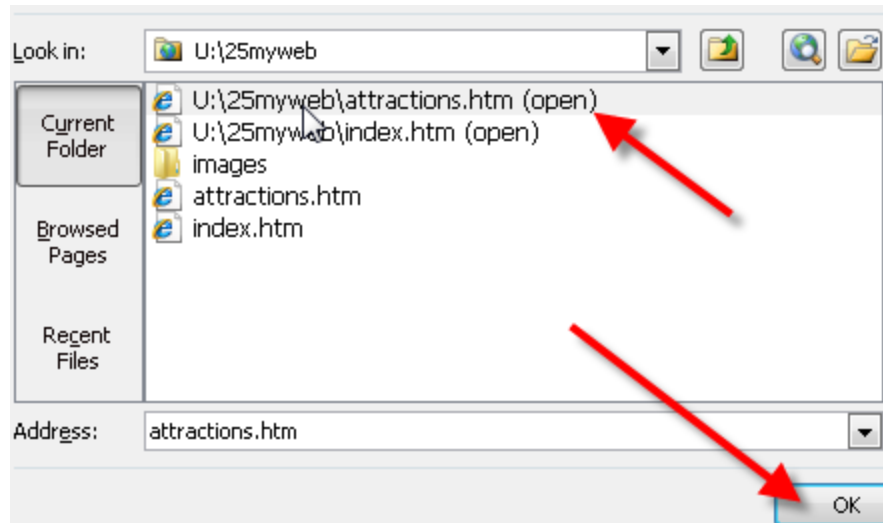
Click on the home page tab to switch back to it and type the word “Attractions” below the graphic:



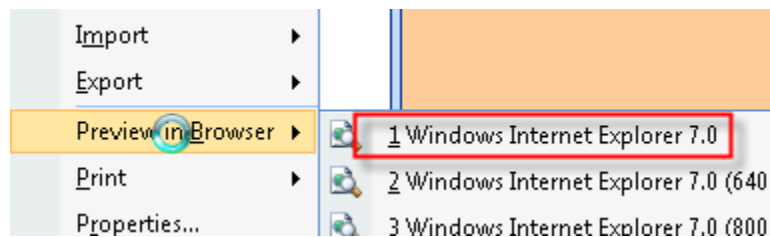
Right click and go to Hyperlink:



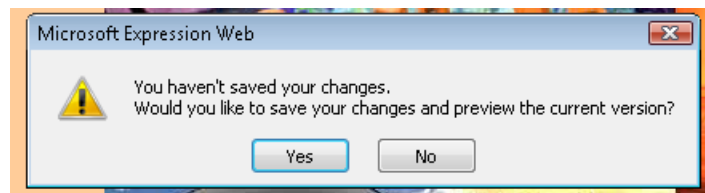
The hyperlink window will open – choose the Attractions page:



Test the hyperlink by going to File>Preview in Browser:



If you haven't saved our changes, you will get this reminder:



Your link should work – close the browser and click on the Attractions page. Type the word Home, and hyperlink it to the Index page. Test both links to make sure they work properly:
