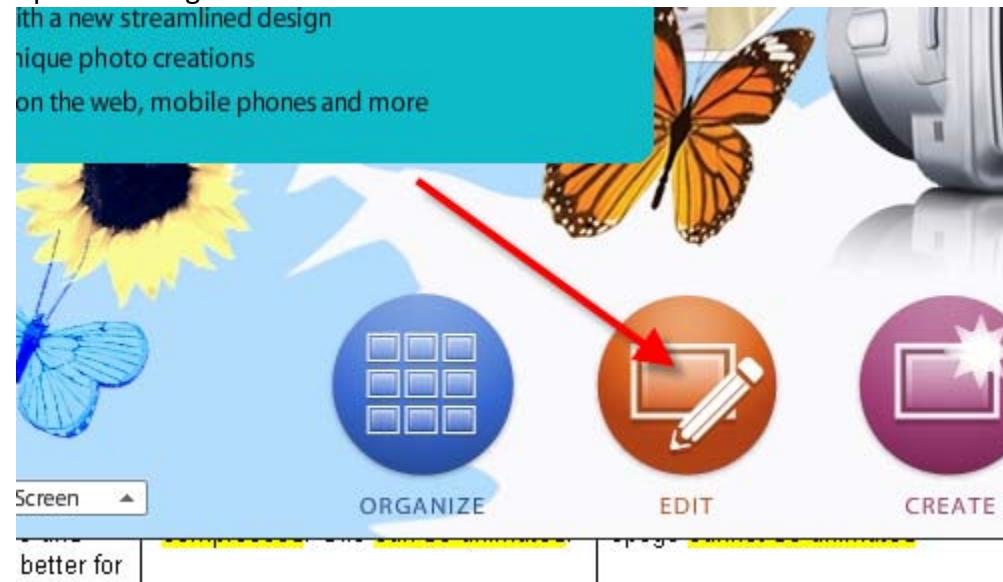
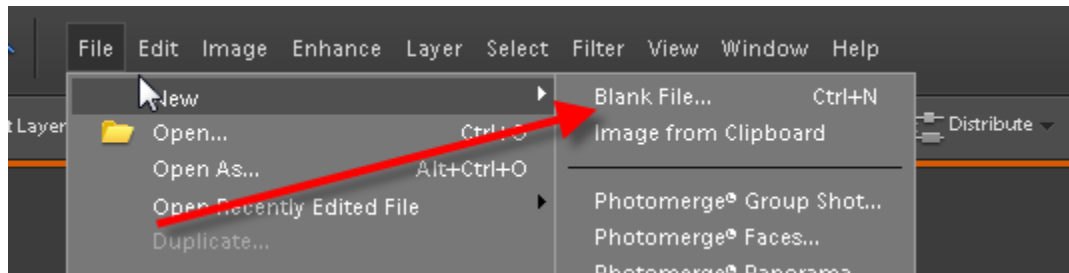


## Simple Logos Using PSE 6/7

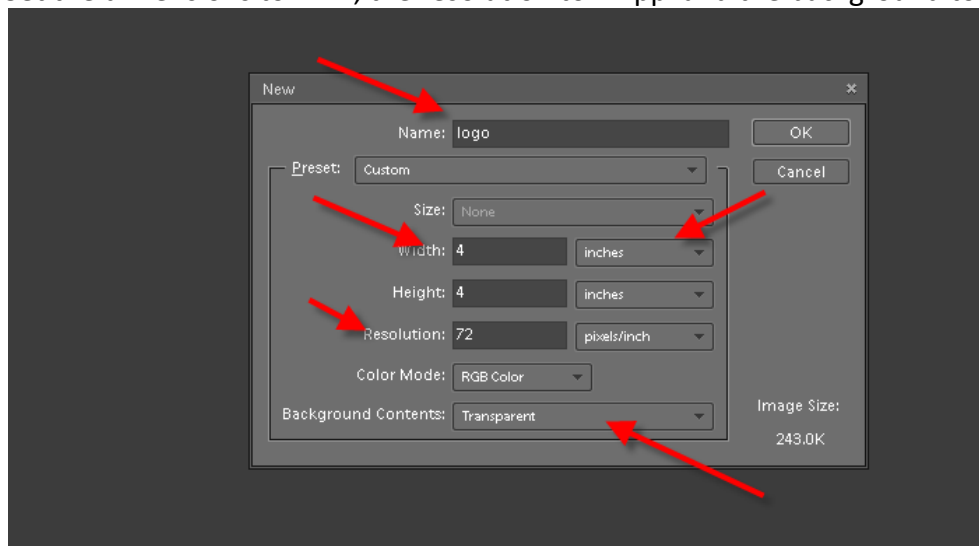
Open the Program and choose Edit:



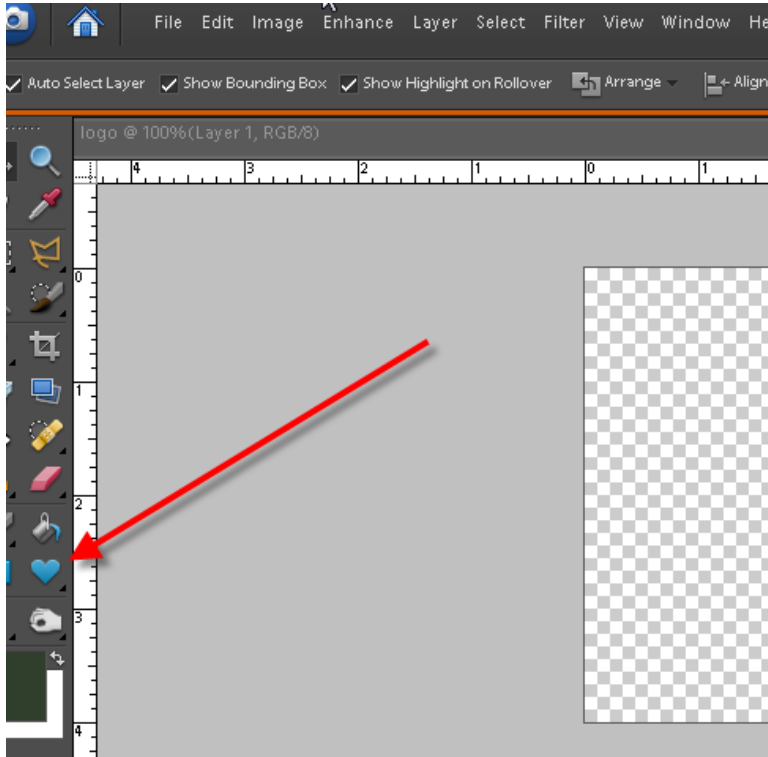
Go to New>Blank File:



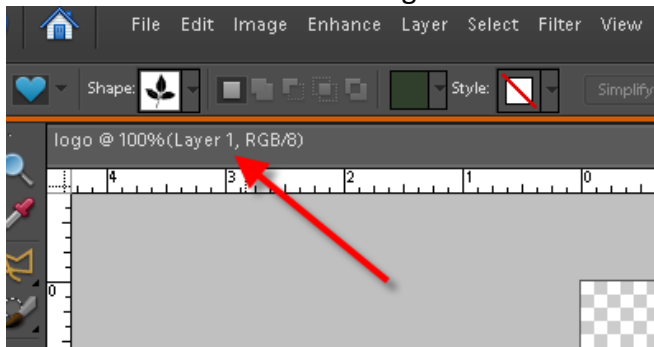
Set the dimensions to 4x4", the resolution to 72 ppi and the background to transparent



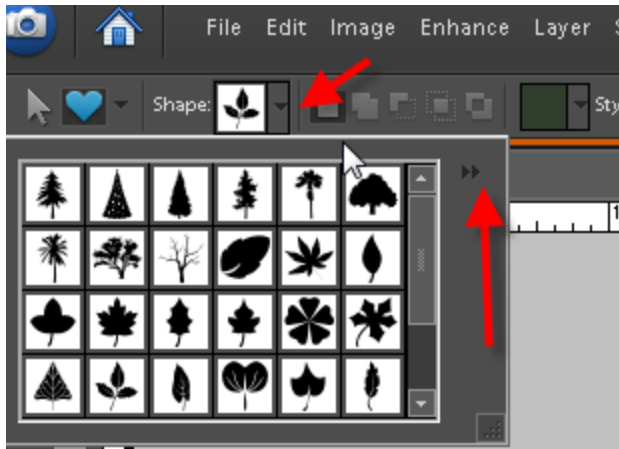
The file will have a checked background – this means that it is transparent, but it will not print or show as transparent when you are finished. On the toolbar, select the Custom Shape Tool;



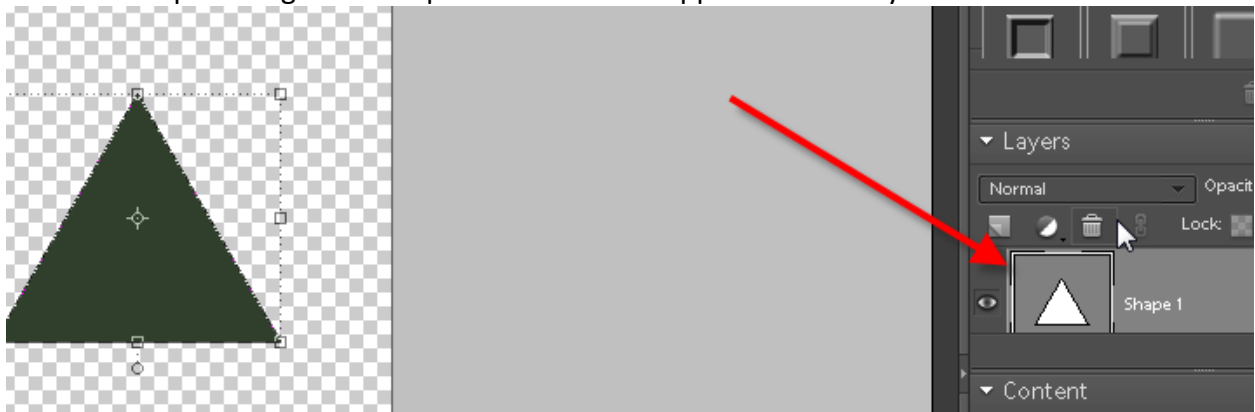
Notice that the menu bar changes when the tool changes:



Explore the shapes by using the arrows:



Choose a simple background shape – notice that it appears in the Layers Palette:



Continue to add layers and shapes:



Save for web to flatten layers
