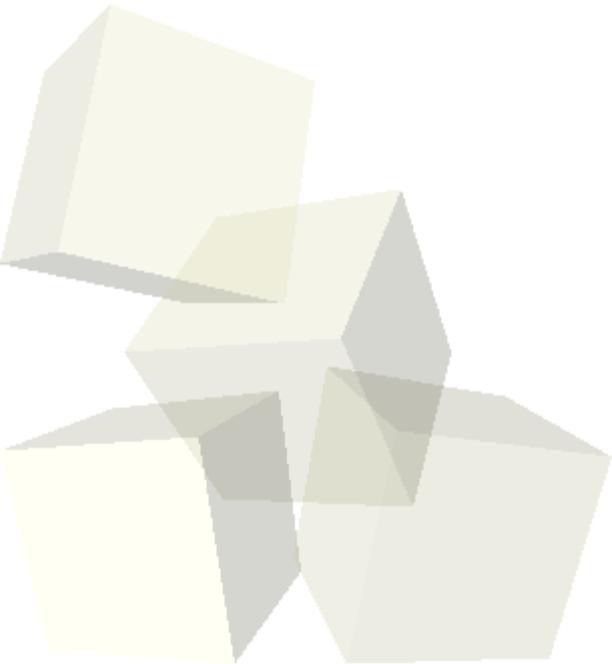

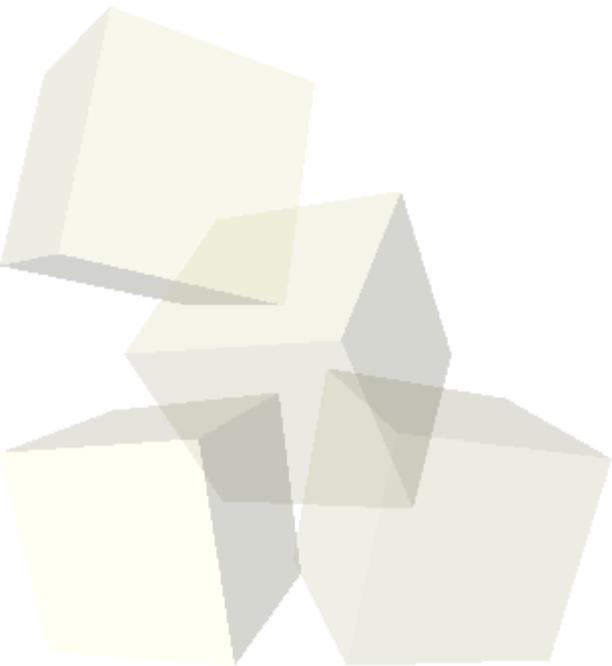



# Midterm Results


- I'll be sending out a solution to the midterm shortly.

# Transition Effects

- Add square objects around the camera opening that can be moved or altered to create effects.
- Fade effect created by moving one square in front on the camera while it is transparent then increasing the opacity to 100%. Do reverse to fade back in.
- Barndoor and iris wipes can be made by moving the squares in front of the camera.
- Reuse these by saving a template file you can build on.
