HTML and Applets

- Your web space on the Linux machines is under Local/HTML-Documents/.
- Anything you put there and make visible can be accessed by a web browser.
- Web pages use HTML (Hypertext Markup Language).
- The `<applet>` tag on a web page tells it that you want to place an applet on it.

Making a Web Page

- Let's try to post one of our applets to the web.
- We can do this through the graphical interface of Linux so you don't have to use command line.
 - Copy the needed .class files into Local/HTML-Documents.
 - Make a new file and copy the code from my applet page into it.
 - Edit the file, change permissions, and view.
